

Below you will see a summary of important changes that we have had to make in order to remain compliant with COVID 19 rules and open safely. Please remember - these are not our rules, we have been ordered to implement them and the penalties for non compliance are huge

- * We MUST operate a full table service. You MUST NOT leave your table during your visit except when visiting the toilet.
- * You MUST WEAR a face covering / mask when inside the pub except when seated at your table
- * You MUST NOT mingle with other guests
- * We have been told that we MUST collect personal contact details for all visitors here. We work to meet the requirement to support the government track & trace effort and do not use them for any other purpose. Our preference is that you scan the government QR code and register your visit. Alternatively, we may take your details and use our Quandoo Booking Application to log your visit. We understand your right to refuse to provide us with your contact details. In this situation, I'm afraid we will be unable to allow you to stay.
- * We only have single use paper menus which we ask you to dispose of in the bin provided or take home with you.
- * We still accept cash payments but ask that you use contactless card payments whenever possible to minimise the risk of viral spread.
- * Customers MUST NOT stand at the bar to drink or chat. You must move away from the bar and sit at a table immediately after you have been served.
- * We do not have a queueing system at the pub but ask customers to respect social distancing and be aware of other people's movements when visiting
- * The outer doors to the toilets will be chocked open to allow visual awareness. Please leave these outer doors open.
- * Our suppliers are finding their feet too. Please bear with us as we will have limited product ranges to begin with
- * Children have always been and continue to be welcome here. They MUST adhere to our social distancing rules. Children MUST remain seated at all times with the only exception being to go to the toilet. We remind all parents & guardians that it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to ensure that the children in your care are compliant with these rules.
- * Failure to comply with these rules will result in service being refused and you will be asked to leave.
